Call to Order

Mr. Perot called the meeting to order at 8:19 a.m.

Invocation

Mr. Owens presented the invocation.

Review of Mission Statement

Ms. Jones presented the mission statement.

Approval of Agenda

Action Item #1: Ms. Jones made a motion to approve the agenda. Ms. Faulkner seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Minutes

Action Item #2: Mr. Pullin made a motion to approve the minutes from the May meeting. Mr. Wyatt seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment

Megan Rowe, Director of the Ruston Sports Complex, welcomed the group and took them on a tour of the indoor facility prior to the start of the meeting.

President/CEO's Report

Ms. Carrier reported that lodging tax was up 43.64% for April and 32.85% year-to-date. She shared that the 72nd Annual Louisiana Peach Festival was a great success with more than 20,000 people coming through during the day.

Action Item #3: Ms. Wyatt made a motion to approve the President's Report. Mr. Owens seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Sales & Marketing Report

Ms. Davis presented the sales and marketing report, reporting strong website and campaign performance numbers for May.

Action Item #4: Mr. Owens made a motion to approve the Sales & Marketing Report. Mr. Pullin seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Community Relations Committee Report

Mr. Durrett shared that the committee reviewed a capital improvement grant application submitted by Desi Bourgeois for the Heard Freighthouse Food Park to help with the creation of a community stage and entertainment space. The committee recommended awarding the requested grant amount of \$35,000 for the project.

Action Item #5: Mr. Durrett made a motion to award the Heard Freighthouse Food Park a \$35,000 capital improvement grant. Mr. Pullin seconded. Mr. Owens abstained from voting. All else present said aye. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report

Mr. Pullin presented the Treasurer's report. He reported that revenues exceeded expenses for the month of May. Revenues exceed expenses for the year.

Action Item #6: Mr. Owens made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Ms. Faulkner seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman's Report

Mr. Perot commended the staff on the success of the recent Peach Festival and looks forward to the continued growth and development of the festival as a tourism driver for the area.

Action Item #7: Mr. Pullin made a motion to approve the Chairman's Report. Ms. Jones seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.
