# **Call to Order**

Mr. Durrett called the meeting to order at 8:24 a.m.

Mr. Napper presented the invocation.

# **Review of Mission Statement**

Mr. Lewis read aloud the CVB mission statement.

# **Approval of Agenda**

Action Item #1: Mr. Lewis made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of the board reviewing and voting on support of upcoming tax. Ms. Givens seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

Action Item #2: Mr. Russell made a motion to approve the minutes from the September meeting. Mr. Lewis seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **Public Comments**

#### President/CEO's Report

Mr. Napper reported that the lodging tax was down 12% for August and down 3% for the year. Mr. Napper reminded the board that a decision on the recipient of the 2018 Hospitality Award needed to be made by the next board meeting. All Enterprise Funds are being reviewed by the dedicated fund review subcommittee. Mr. Napper reminded the board of upcoming activities for LA Tech homecoming, including Rock the Railroad. He informed the board the CVB staff met and gave presentation on Tourism Summit topics this past week, and that Ms. Quimby was married on Oct. 6. He announced the Lincoln Parish Police Jury has approved the CVB budget for 2019. Mr. Napper also announced that the CVB's logo and "Experience Ruston" are now trademarked and the new visitors guides have arrived.

Action Item #3: Mr. Russell made a motion to approve the President/CEO Report. Mr. Newman seconded. All present said aye. Motion passed unanimously.

# **Treasurer's Report**

Mr. Napper gave the financial report for September. Revenues exceeded Expenses for the month. He pointed out that the CVB would be receiving upgrade phone systems soon.
